GENERAL: MR TOM SMITH RESIDENT OF LEOPARD ROAD ATTENDED MEETING WITH COMPLAINTS ABOUT THE CONDITION OF LEOPARD ROAD. HE TOLD BOARD THAT THE ROAD HAD NOT BEEN MOWED OR PATCHED FOR SOME TIME. BOARD TOLD HIM THAT DUE TO SHORTAGE OF MAN POWER, PLUS THE COST OF ROAD MATERIAL IT NOT EASY TO KEEP UP. BOARD INFORMED HIM OF THE ROAD LEVY THAT WILL BE ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT AND ASK FOR HIS SUPPORT FOR THIS LEVY. BOARD AGREED TO SEND WORKERS OUT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. MR SMITH THEN THANKED THE TRUSTEES FOR THEIR CONCERN FOR THIS MATTER.

TRUSTEES DISCUSSED THE ROAD PATCHER AND ALSO THE BACK-HOE REPAIRS. TRUSTEE JOE CHIURCO TOLD BOARD THAT HE WAS WAITING FOR THE PARTS. JOE ALSO TOLD BOARD THAT THE REPAIRS TO THE BACK-HOE DUE TO THE RECENT STORM DAMAGE REQUIRED PARTS TO BE ORDERED ALSO.

BOARD AGEED TO HAVE THE ROADMEN CONTINUALLY WORK ON ROAD MAINTENANCE.

TRUSTEES AGREED TO REPLACE A LAMP POST THAT WAS DAMAGED OF A PROPERTY OWNER ON 7/16/2014 , DUE TO MOWING.

BOARD AGREED TO ALLOW THE NEW HIRE CHARLES WALLACE, VISION, LIFE-ADD, CANCER AND DENTAL INSURANCE.
