JULY 7, 2014 MEETING

GENERAL: MR LARRY BANKER FROM MAGNET ROAD ATTENDED TO COMPLAIN ABOUT THE CONDITION OF MAGNET ROAD AND FIND OUT WHEN WORK WOULD GET DONE. TRUSTEE JOE CHIURCO TOLD HIM THAT THE ROAD WAS GOING TO BE CHIPPED AND SEALED MID TO LATE AUGUST. HE THEN TOLD MR BANKERT THAT HE WOULD HAVE THE ROAD DEPARTMENT GO AND REPAIR THE POTHOLES. MR BANKERT THEN THANKED THE TRUSTEES.

THE BOARD RECEIVED A CALL ABOUT JUNK CARS ON RIVERVIEW, BOARD AGREED TO SEND A LETTER TO THE CURRENT PROPERTY OWNER.

NOTICE: SYCAMORE ROAD AND KOPP ROAD ARE NO LONGER BROWN TOWNSHIP MAINTAINED ROADS. DUE TO THE RECENT ANNEXATION FOR THE NEW SCHOOL THE VILLAGE OF MALVERN WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS.

BOARD SIGNED A LETTER OF INTENT TO LEASE/PURCHASE A FLAIL MOWER FROM SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT.

TRUSTEES AGREED TO REQUEST AN EXTENTION FOR THE BUDGET HEARING FOR 2015 UNTIL **JULY 28, 2014 AT 1:00PM.**

TRUSTEE PASSED **RESOLUTION 05-14-** TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF QUESTION OF LEVYING A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION ORC 5705.19, ORC 5705.191, ORC 5705.25, ORC 5705.26. TRUSTEE RODNEY G. WISE MADE MOTION, SECONDED BY TRUSTEE EDDIE L. CLARK. THIS LEVY IS FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-1/2 MILL WHICH AMOUNTS TO 7.875 FOR EACH ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF VALUATION FOR FIVE YEARS. THIS IS FOR THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND ANY NECESSARY REPAIRS TO EXISTING TOWNSHIP ROADS. O.R.C.5705.19-G.THIS WOULD COST THE AVERAGE HOME OWNER OF A \$100.000 HOME \$78.75 PER YEAR FOR FIVE YEARS.

BOARD HIRED MR. CHARLES R. WALLACE FOR A TEMPORARY FULL TIME POSITION AT A RATE OF \$12.00 PER HOURS PLUS HOSPITALIZATION REIMBURSEMENT WITH PROPER DOCUMENTATION, HOLIDAY AND VACATION PAY.

CEMETERY: THE BETHLEHEM CEMETERY RECEIVED A LETTER DONATING A GRAVE PLOT BACK TO THE TOWNSHIP. TRUSTEES AGREED TO SEND A THANK YOU CARD OF APPRECIATION.
